SUNMBEAM INTERNATIONAL MINISTRIES ACTIVITIY REPORT : FOR YEAR 2016-17

Greetings Dear Board Members and all our dear supporters and prayer partners.

The following brief account of activity for the year 2016-17 is appended below for our information.

1. Day Care Centre (Aaroon's Nest) : Children at our project Aaroon's Home were taken good care by Miss. Grace Alimuthu, at Aaroon's Nest. Our care taker cum teacher, Ms. Grace stayed with the children through the year 2016 and met the needs of all children, taking them for medical checkups and also each of them were provided with school books for the academic year 2016-17 and gifts during their respective festivals. All their special fees as requested by Miss Grace were taken care as per the requests.

2. Sport For Life : Skills Development (Football Coaching)

The last two years we were able to support and raise more than 300 Football players and many senior players as coaches under the leadership of Mr. Sathya and Miss Anita. The Boys were taken to Camps for special sessions on leaderships in different batches. Daily morning and evening coaching for all the boys providing them breakfast and and evening snacks and special diet are provided regularly. Adventure camps as Leadership training was also conducted.

3. Child Protection & Girl Child Education : Computer Education, Tailoring Class and English Speaking Class

The last two years we were able to support 60 young girls and 4 Teachers under the leadership of Miss Anita. The girls were provided opportunities to take up leadership roles at the community

and schools were they are studying. There were special Leadership Computer education, Tailoring Classes and English speaking class conudcted throughout the year 2016-17.

4. Community Children : Evening Tuitions

Over 40 children were provided with Evening Tuitions under the leadership of Mercy Nathan and the same is continuing at Frazer Town Slum.

5. Anti Human Trafficking Project (Freedom for Bondage and & Slavery) : An Investigation Team working alongside the Karnataka Police was set up to rescue the women in Bondage and slavery (Prostitution) and also provided regular medical and visits to the Karnataka Department of Women and Welfare were made for the women staying at the Azadi Home. These women were rescued from the clutches of human trafficking with the help of Karnataka AHTU Force, the women were placed in the Azadi Home which is handled by Miss Anita. Awareness on Anti Human Trafficking continues to be a core of Sunbeam International Ministry under the leadership Mr. Patterson SR. Medical camps for project girls and their family were conducted.

6. Christmas gifts were distributed to all the boys and girls and their families.

7. All financial documents have been audit by M/s Charles Prabakar & Associates and found to be in order.
