SUNMBEAM INTERNATIONAL MINISTRIES ACTIVITIY REPORT FOR YEAR ENDING 31 MAR 2020

Greetings Dear Board Members and all our dear supporters and prayer partners.

The following brief account of activity for the year 2019-20 is appended below for our information.

1. Aaroon's Nest: The Project was closed and handed over to Miss Grace Alimuthu to manage with here own financial assistance due to funds crunch.

All of the children are being taken good care by Miss. Grace Alimuthu. Our team visted them during Christmas and prayed and spent the day with them. With COVID-19 pandamic, all children were sent back to their guardians in the month of March 2020.

2. Skills Development : Football Coaching

During the current year we have conducted coaching on Leadership for 40 children each in 5 batches from Apr to Aug 2019 under the leadership of Sathya. During November-December 2019 the team leaders and coaches met for a planning meeting for 2020-21 and the leadership prayed for the ingoing skills development programs.

Due to COVID-19 the football teams are not meeting from Feb 2020 onwards. However, coaching on Leadership for 40 children each in 4 batches from Feb to March 2019 were conducted online with Mr. Patterson SR.

3. Community Children: Evening Tuitions

Over 60 children were provided with Evening Tuitions under the leadership of Mercy Nathan and the same is continuing at Frazer Town Slum but from the last week of February 2020 all class were cancelled due to COVID -19. The children are monitored with their parents on mobile phones.

- 4. **Anti Human Trafficking Awareness:** The Volunteer team of GO-Cycle have travelled across 5 states covering 2300 kms bringing in the message of Anti Human Trafficking in Govt. Schools and villages for over 12 days with the leadership of Mr. Patterson SR.
- 5. **Audit Report Y/E 2019-2020**: All financial documents for year ending 2019-2020 have been audit by M/s Charles Prabakar & Associates and found to be in order.
