With COVID-19 pandemic, all children were sent back to their guardians in the month of March 2020 hence only online support is being rendered by Miss Grace Alimuthu. We look forward for early resumption of all our activities in the years to come.

**2. Community Children: Evening Tuitions**

Over 60 children were continuously monitored and provided with online home Tuitions under the leadership of Mercy Nathan and the same is continuing at Frazer Town Slum due to COVID -19. The children are monitored with their parents on mobile phones. We are praying that the situation will resume and children will be able to return for regular class soon.

**3. Online Anti Human Trafficking Awareness :** Awareness on Anti Human Trafficking continues to be a core of Sunbeam International Ministry under the leader the leadership Mr. Patterson SR. He is continuing to empower Volunteer teams and college students on topic and issues pertaining to Human Trafficking and Value of the Physical Body and its its protection from various forms of Abuse. Regular online training and prayer meets are being conducted via Zoom.

4. All financial docs for the year ending 2020-21 have been audited by M/s Charles Prabakar & Associates, and found to be in order.
