

**SUNMBEAM INTERNATIONAL MINISTRIES ACTIVITY REPORT**  
**FOR 3 QTR ENDING JUN- SEP-DEC 2021-22**

Greetings Dear Board Members and all our dear supporters and prayer partners.

The following brief account of activity for the year 2021-22 is appended below for our information.

**1. Aaroon's Nest :** The Project was closed and handed over to Miss Grace Alimuthu to manage with her own financial assistance due to funds crunch. With COVID-19 pandemic, all children were sent back to their guardians in the month of March 2020. Our care taker cum teacher Miss Grace Alimuthu continues to monitor through phone and periodic visits. We are praying the situation will change soon and the life for these small children will be more meaningful and joyful.

**2. Skills Development : Football Coaching**

The last 4 years we were able to support and raise 400 Football players and 30 coaches under the leadership of Mr. Sathya and Miss Anita. During the current year we have handed over the project to them to take it and continue with their own financial support. Sunbeam International Ministry will continue to be a prayer partner and all the assets provided to them will remain on the name of Sunbeam International Ministries.

**3. Development of Girl Child : Computer Education, Tailoring Class and English Speaking Class**

The last 4 years we were able to support 60 young girls and 4 Teachers under the leadership of Miss Anita. During the current year we have handed over the project to Miss Anita to take it up and continue with their own financial support. Sunbeam International Ministry will continue to be a prayer partner and all the assets provided to them will remain on the name of Sunbeam International Ministries.

#### **4. Community Children : Evening Tuitions**

Over 40 children were provided with Evening Tuitions under the leadership of Mercy Nathan and the same is continuing at Frazer Town Slum.

5. **Anti Human Trafficking Awareness** : After successful rescue of women from from the clutches of human trafficking with the help of Karnataka AHTU Force, the women were placed in the Azadi Home which is now handed over to Miss Anita. Awareness on Anti Human Trafficking continues to be a core of Sunbeam International Ministry under the leader the leadership MR. Patterson SR. A Volunteer team of GO-Cycle have travelled across Karnataka covering 1800 kms bringing in the message of Anti Human Trafficking in Govt. Schools and villages for over 10 days with the leadership of Mr. Patterson SR.

6. All financial documents have been audit by M/s Charles Prabakar & Associates and found to be in order.
